### THE POSITION

Deputy Agricultural Commissioners are responsible for administering, managing, and directing a complex agricultural or weights and measures program, or several less complex programs; supervising Agricultural Biologists/Standards Specialists; and performing inspections in the enforcement of federal, state and local laws and regulations including the State Food and Agricultural Code, California Code of Regulations, Code of Federal Regulations, Uniform Fire Code, Sonoma County Ordinances and the State Health and Safety Code, which protect the agricultural and horticultural industries of the County, protect the health and safety of agricultural workers and the public, and safeguard the environment.

### THE AGRICULTURAL COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE

The Agricultural Commissioner's Office, now under the leadership of former Mendocino County Agricultural Commissioner Tony Linegar, is dedicated to delivering services that effectively promote and protect agriculture, the economy, community, environment, and the health and safety of our citizens through education and the enforcement of laws and regulations, resulting in sustainable agriculture and equity in the marketplace. The Agricultural Commissioner's Office also oversees and administers the County's grading and draining ordinance and provides staff support to the Fish and Wildlife Commission. The Agricultural Commissioner's Office includes two divisions: Agricultural and Weights & Measures.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

The minimum qualifications for this position include:

- Completion of course work necessary to acquire a state-wide Deputy Agricultural Commissioner's License.
- One year of full time paid experience in a position comparable to Senior Agricultural Biologist/Standards Specialist
- A valid Deputy Agricultural Commissioner's License issued by the Secretary of the California Department of Food and Agriculture.
